From the Pastor's Desk

Dear Parishioners;

We are in the heart of the Easter Season and as the Church reminds us, it is the Springtime of our Church. The month of May brings much to remind us of the Resurrection. When we look around we see that God's Divine Providence was at work when His Son, Our Lord Jesus Christ, completed the Father's work. We see so much life around us springing up from the darkness of winter we had just experienced prior to The Easter Celebrations. Once again this week we see the final group of our 2nd grade Religious Education children receive First Holy Communion. It was truly a pleasure and a joy to see them coming forward to join their faith community to share in the reality of who we are and what we believe. Jesus reminds us that we have no life in us if we do not eat His flesh and drink His Blood. Each Sunday when we share in the Eucharistic meal, we are filled with life, an abundant life in Jesus Christ. The Eucharist is a reality, not just a sign or symbol of Christ's presence. He is truly present; His body, Blood, Soul and Divinity, really, substantially, and wholly present.

This mystery, I know, is hard to believe for those who do not share our faith. But, Christ Himself made this reality of our faith known to us and has been reaffirmed by our Church's teaching. If anyone has doubt about Christ's presence in the Eucharist, let them explore the Eucharistic miracle at Lanciano, or Santarem, two of many that Christ used to convert the hearts of doubters.

My brothers and sisters, we are a Eucharistic people called to love one another even when we find it hard to love. This is the truth and reality of our faith and the Eucharist. The Eucharist is Love! Out of love it has been given to us and through love it is shared with one another. Then it is right and just that, as a Eucharistic people, we give a good example to these children as they begin to share this reality of faith with us. We should not be left wanting before them or our God. In the Gospels we hear Jesus say; “by their love you will know they are Mine, and by their actions you will know they are My disciples”. May we truly make ourselves worthy to be called His and be an example of Christ to our Children.
