



### Notes on the 2025 Annual Appeal

- This year St. Mary's Annual Appeal Goal is \$48,081.
- If you have already donated, thank you. Be sure that St. Mary's Nutley is noted for your donation.
- We are moving forward toward our goal but we still have 95 donors from 2024 that we still haven't heard from. Please take some time before Easter to make your donation or pledge so we can reach our goal by Easter.
- 50% of money collected over our goal comes back to the parish for our Heritage Fund Projects.
- Every parish who reaches their goal will receive a 2% reduction of the next year's assessment (tax of our collection income)

## Rosary Society Annual Charity Baby Shower

On Monday, June 2, 2025, St. Mary's Rosary Society will host their Annual Baby Shower at 7:00 PM in the Phoenix Center Cafeteria. We are sponsoring **New Hope of Westwood** NJ. New Hope provides single first-time mothers and their babies a mentoring program to help the women attain financial stability via a meaningful career.

New Hope provides among other things cribs, blankets, diapers, and clothing for the babies. This year a request has been made for much needed items such as:

- Baby wash
- Baby shampoo
- Laundry detergent and wipes
- Newborn sized diapers
- Size 5 & 6 diapers
- Size 4T-5T pull ups

- Girls' Clothing:
  - o 18 months, 24 months, 2 T, 3 T, 4 T, and 5 T
  - o Girls' Pajamas: 6-9 mo, 24 mo, and 18 mo
- Boys' Clothing:
  - o 6-9 mo, 9-12 mo, 2 T, 3 T, 4T and 5 T
  - Boys' Pajamas: 24 mo and 4T
- Sweatshirts jackets or spring jackets in 3T, 4T and 5T for both boys and girls.

We invite all women of the parish to attend this meeting. Refreshments will be served.

In addition, bins will be located in the Church vestibule for anyone wishing to donate baby items.

## 3 Advantages of a Family-Based Model

- Parents are not picking up children whose response to "what did you learn today," is "nothing." Parents will be learning with them.
- Families can incorporate foundations of Catholicism into the family system to bring a greater sense of joy to the home.
- Parents with multiple children are not dropping their children off once a week on different days to learn in a classroom and tax the busy schedules
