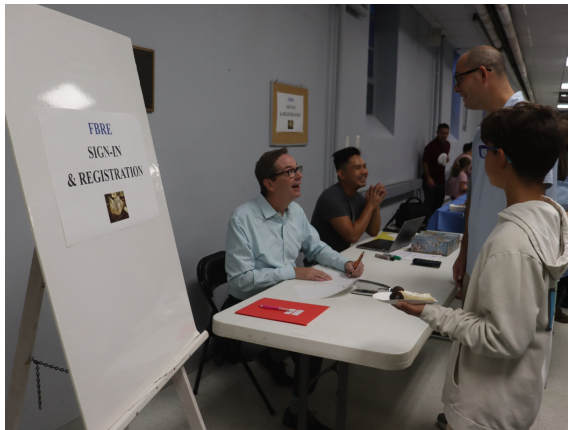
Thank You for a Wonderful Start to Family Based Religious Education!
