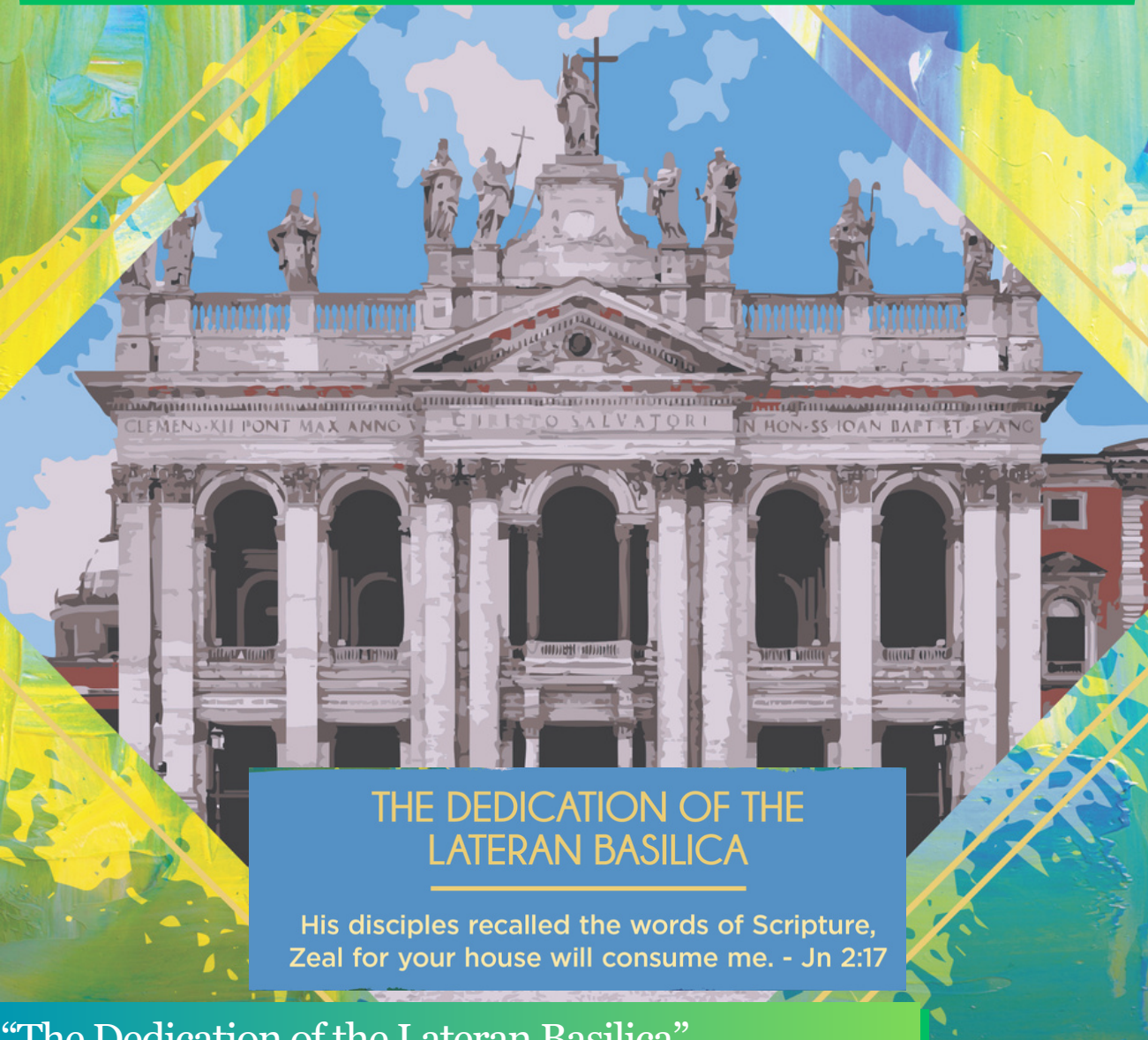

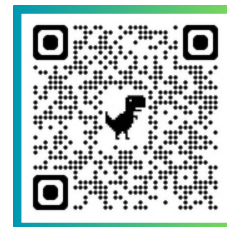

Your Electronic Donation to the Parish

Of the \$355,000 collected each year in the weekly offertory at St. Mary's, \$115,000 is donated electronically, through a secure process called Parish Giving. This helps the parish cash flow tremendously!

Online donations are safe and simple, saving the parish the expense of printing and mailing envelopes and making the transfer of money less risky since it goes from your bank or credit card directly to the parish bank. Many parishioners also enjoy getting reward points if they choose to use a credit card. 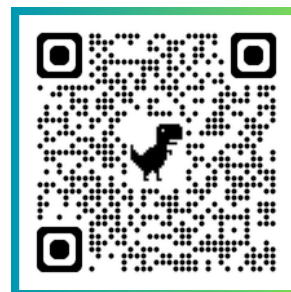
Nearly 50,000 parishioners completed the Disciple Maker Index last spring. Much more data has been provided and feedback over the last few months from priests, deacons, religious, Key Parish Leaders and Parish Points of Contact. The information has been fruitful as we continue to ask ourselves what our parishes, ministries, and institutions need to look like as we journey together on our path of pastoral conversion and reimagine parish life, mission and ministry in response to a changing world.

The next step in this multi-year process is to hear more robustly from parishioners about our specific parish and the initial, not final, model option: St. Mary's Nutley joining with Our Lady of Mt Carmel Lyndhurst Parish OR St. Mary's Nutley continues on as a standalone Parish. Parishioners are invited to register for their parish's listening session beginning today at <https://www.catholicleaders.org/archdiocese-newark-parishsessionregistration> or using the QR code on this page. Parishioners must register to attend a Listening Session. If you are not able to attend a listening session you will still have the opportunity to offer feedback.

Each listening session will be facilitated by volunteer parishioners from a different parish. These trained facilitators will share pre-recorded messages from Cardinal Tobin and Auxiliary Bishop Michael Saporito, with an overview of We Are His Witnesses, a planning area overview and the option for our parish. Time will be allowed for small group discussion and facilitated large group feedback. The information presented at all three sessions is the same.

The goals of the listening sessions are to engage as many parishioners as possible in understanding the current state of our parishes and archdiocese, and to solicit feedback from as many parishioners as possible about the draft model options for our planning area.

All parishioners will be asked to submit their feedback to the draft model through an online survey which will remain open until November 30, 2025. Parishioner feedback to the model is critical as it will be used to help shape the future of the Archdiocese of Newark. The link to give feedback will be found on **www.WeAreHisWitnesses.org** once the parish sessions begin.

Your participation and feedback is important to the future of St. Mary's. Please continue to pray for the gift of true discernment so that we may continue to do the Will of God in all things.
