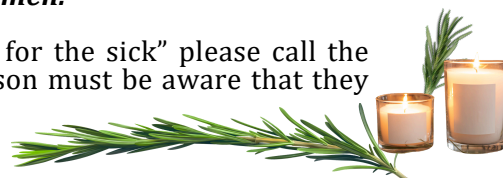

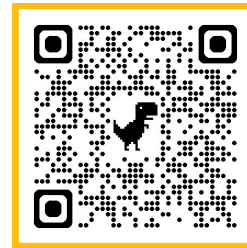

ANNUAL ²⁰²⁶ APPEAL

With two months to go in the Appeal, we are on target to reach last year's total. The **GOOD NEWS** is that the **average gift amount has increased** compared to last year. The **BAD NEWS** is that we are **still missing 56 donors** who gave a gift last year to the appeal.

Addressing Our Parish Deficit

As part of our commitment to transparency, we share this update with gratitude and hope:

After 9 months, we are currently operating with a **\$78,710 deficit** (expenses over income) largely due to unexpected costs. A severe winter brought higher utility and insurance bills, along with major unplanned expenses: boiler and water heater repairs, \$25,000 in snow removal and salt, and damage to our roof and facilities.

We have also experienced a 10% decline in collections, and we mourn the loss of three generous parishioners whose support helped sustain our parish for many years.

And yet, we are deeply grateful.

Because of your continued generosity, St. Mary's remains a vibrant place of worship, community, and tradition. Thank you for all you have done—and continue to do—to support our parish.
